

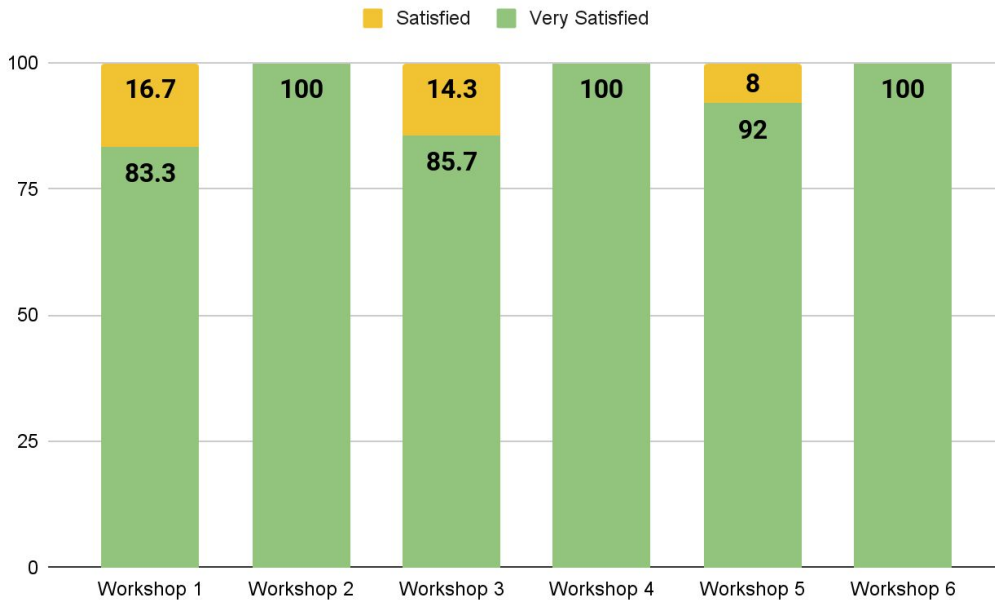


PATHWAY TO FOOD SECURITY & EQUITY WORKSHOP SUMMARY REPORT

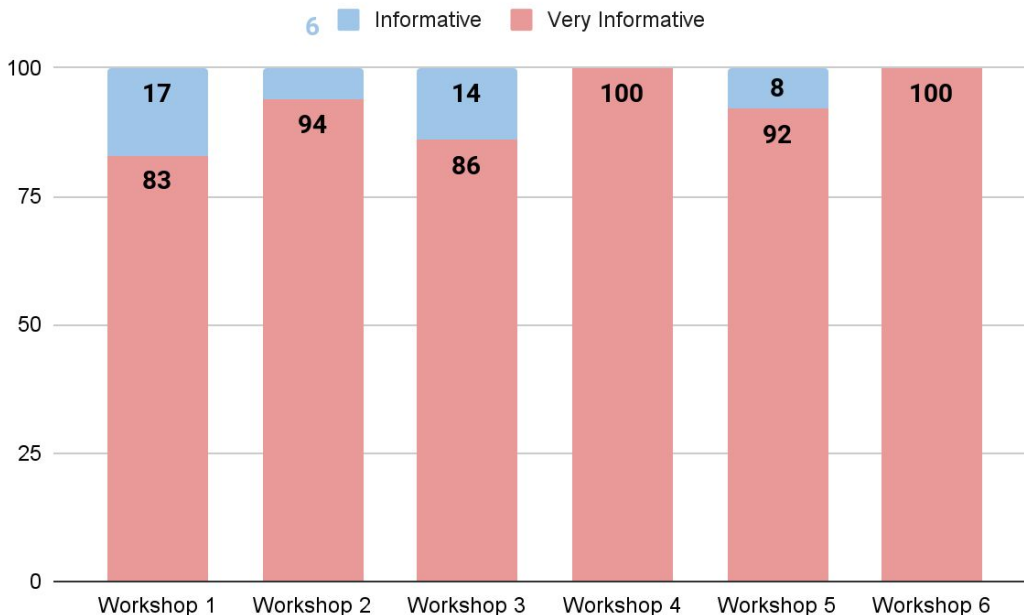
June 2023

HOW INFORMATIVE THE WORKSHOP WAS (in %)

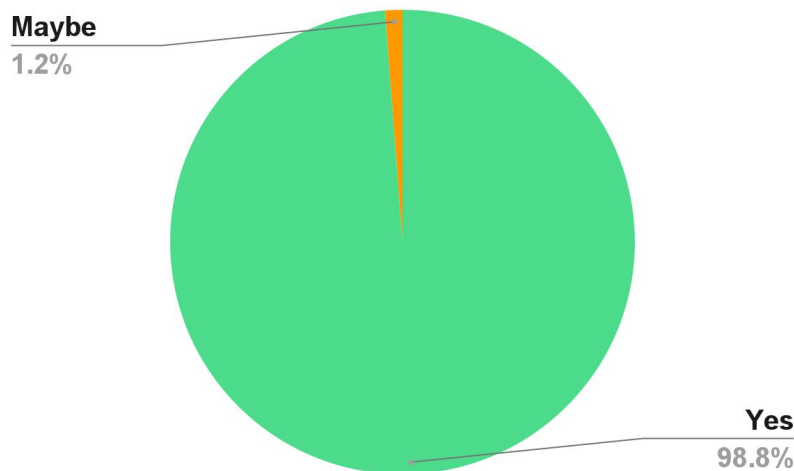
